

Addendum to the 2003 Technology Initiative Grant (TIG) RFP

Category: Web Sites

C. Third Year Web Site Funding

Recipients of TIG 2000 or 2001 statewide web site grants, who have received a renewal web site grant in 2002, and who have *completed, reported on and been approved by LSC for successful achievement of their first quarter milestones by April 30th, 2003, may apply for additional funding up to \$25,000. This funding will not begin until after the 2002 renewal grant has been completed and will be for a grant term of twenty-four months. Funds are contingent on the following: a two year commitment of website hosting by a provider, ongoing in-house content development, management and upgrades and for continued outreach and sustainability efforts.

***Grantees who have successfully completed their first year grant, except for the required evaluation and who have also completed months one through six on the renewal grant, except for milestones two and four (both associated with evaluation), may submit a waiver request for LSC's consideration.**

All awarded grants will be conditioned on completion of the final evaluation and milestones two and four of the renewal grant once the TEP evaluation tools are tested and available. LSC estimates this will take approximately three to six months.

States who may qualify to apply for a waiver in this category are: Alaska, Colorado, Florida, Hawaii, Minnesota and Virgin Islands.

Maximum grant amount in this category is \$25,000 for twenty-four months.
